

'Guidelines': Approval as producer of EPAL CP pallets

- 1. **You** send us an application for EPAL approval as a producer of EPAL CP pallets (this can just be an email info@epal-pallets.org).
- 2. **We** then send you various documents.
- 3. **You** sign the enclosed note of obligation after studying these documents and send them back to us with a **copy of your business registration.**
- 4. We will instruct our competent international inspection company to carry out an evaluation visit.
- 5. On the day of the evaluation visit please provide proof of the following:
 - a) an equipped production facility
 - b) various tools (saws, etc.)
 - c) various machines, if not integrated into the facility:
 - cutting machine for boards (alternatively: buy in boards)
 - cutting machine for blocks (alternatively: buy in blocks)
 - planing machine (not strictly necessary)
 - nailing machine for legs
 - nailing machine for decks
 - nailing machine for assembly
 - chamfering equipment for bottom boards (not strictly necessary)
 - branding device with branding plates
 - corner cutting device

NOTE:

Manual production is possible as an alternative to machine production. Then the following are compulsory:

- dimensionally accurate templates for leg production
- dimensionally accurate templates for top deck production
- a dimensionally accurate template for assembly
- dimensionally accurate templates for nail positioning
- nailing devices



The following apply generally to both production types:

- a) dimensionally accurate materials
- b) approved nails according to the EPAL-approved list
- c) a version of the Technical Regulations for each CP pallet type 1-9
- d) a staple gun (not compulsory but useful)
- e) digital calipers; one each of 1,500 mm and 300 mm

NOTE: if you have no staple gun, our inspection company will invoice the additional cost for monitoring stapling.

- f) a wood moisture meter
- g) 100 newly produced EPAL CP pallets as test models
- 7. Our competent inspection company will forward the assessment report to us. After examining this, we will send you, in duplicate, our trademark licensing agreement with your approval number.
- **8.** You then sign both copies and send one back to us.
- **9. We** then send you a countersigned copy as well as your approval certificate.
- 10. You may start to produce EPAL CP pallets as soon as you have received the approval certificate.
- 11. You report to EPAL the number of EPAL CP pallets that you have produced. Subsequently our inspection company will get in touch with you and you arrange a date for a (*chargeable*) inspection of the EPAL CP pallets that you have produced.

If your inspection has a positive outcome, our competent inspection company will provide you with EPAL control staples corresponding to the number of pallets in the test lot presented.

If your inspection has a negative outcome, it will be decided if the rejected EPAL CP pallets could be reworked, or if the marking has to be removed.

- **12. EPAL** calculates the graduated inspection and licence fees on the basis of the presented test lots. For fee enquiries, please contact EPAL directly.
- **13.** After 6 months **you** have the opportunity of applying for Level 2 approval (self-monitoring), as long as you can demonstrate continuous production which complies to the standards and the checks by our inspection company in this time show no serious faults.
- **14. We** raise an invoice for the licensing fees annually, so that you may use the trademarked symbols legally.
